

DATA PROTECTION INFORMATION

Dear Client,

protecting your personal data is important to us. According to the EU's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), we are obliged to inform you about the purpose for which we collect, store or forward data. This information also tells you what rights you have in terms of data protection.

1. RESPONSIBILITY FOR DATA PROCESSING

2. PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING

The data processing is carried out in order to fulfill the coaching contract between you and us, as well as the associated obligations.

To this end, we process your personal data to the extent necessary; this information may include health data disclosed to us.

Collecting personal data is a prerequisite for successful coaching. If the necessary information is not provided, attentive coaching cannot take place.

3. RECIPIENTS OF YOUR DATA

We will only transmit your personal data to third parties if this is permitted by law or you have consented.

The transmission is mainly for the purpose of invoicing for the services provided to you. In individual cases, data may be transmitted to other authorized recipients.

4. STORAGE OF YOUR DATA

We retain your personal data only as long as is necessary to implement the coaching.

5. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to obtain information about the personal data we hold concerning you. You can also request the correction of incorrect data.

In addition, under certain circumstances, you also have the right to delete data, the right to restrict data processing and the right to data portability.

Your data is processed based on legal regulations. Only in exceptional cases do we require your consent. In these cases, you have the right to withdraw consent for future processing.

You also have the right to complain to the relevant data protection supervisory authority if you consider that your personal data has not been or is not being processed lawfully.
